1	Modification in the demand of MMR vaccine	The demand for MMR vaccine should be considered modified to 90,000 vials (5 doses each vial)
2	Delivery of vaccines	Delivery of MMR and typhoid vaccine shall be directly to Medical Store, DFW, Battery lane, Delhi so that required cold chain maintenance is ensured.
3	Vaccine quality Issues	VVM should be affixed on each vaccine vial . Vaccines are normally supplied after analysis from Govt Lab, Kasauli. Therefore vaccine shall not be normally sent for lab analysis. But whenever it shall be done, the cost involved in such testing shall be recovered from the bidder/supplier.
4	Invoice issues	Bidder is free to raise invoice from any place in India as legally feasible with preference from Delhi and may or may not be registered with Delhi VAT. Price quoted in this tender shall thus include CST also wherever applicable.
