OFFICE MEMORANDUM

The Competent Authority hereby approves the guidelines for reimbursement of Insulin Pump and Accessories under DGEHS for the beneficiaries who are suffering from classical Type-I Diabetes, the recommendations of which are as follows:

- The provision of Insulin Infusion Pump shall only be considered for classical Type I Diabetics.
- The Insulin Infusion Pump must be advised/ratified by the Endocrinologist of GNCT of Delhi.
- iii. As a matter of policy Insulin Infusion Pump without sensor shall be considered for the patient.
- iv. In rare circumstances sensor augmented Insulin Infusion Pump may also be considered. Such cases shall be considered by the Committee.
- fusion Pump-Rs. 1,20,000/- or actual whichever is less, (b) v. The ceiling rate fixed for (a) Infusion Pump-Rs. 1,20,000/- or actual whichever is less, (c) Insulin shall be reimbursed at actual rates.
 - vi. Reimbursement of Insulin Pump shall be processed by the concerned Administrative Department as per the provisions contained in CS (MA) Rules for procurement of machines.

Furtther, a Committee of following doctors under the chairmanship of Director, Health Services will advice/ratify the Insulin Infusion Pump and the need for sensor Augmented Insulin Pump on case to case basis.
